

1. Describe a time you felt "overjoyed" in the presence of Jesus. What led to this moment?
2. Our culture today is very different from the time when Jesus was born. What might "bowing down" in worship look and feel like today?
3. The Christmas season is a natural time to talk about and share the true significance of the birth of Jesus. What are some organic ways we can talk about who Jesus is and what He means to us during this time of the year?

Read: Psalm 95:6 and 1 Chronicles 16: 29-36

4. Psalm 89 through 100 offers beautiful, eloquent tributes to our Lord. Select two, read them aloud and share your reactions.
5. When you read "I will say of the Lord, He is my refuge and my fortress, my God in whom I trust", what feelings and emotions stir inside of you? Describe your personal trust level in God during this season of your life?
6. What is one way you seek to "bring glory to the Lord" in your daily life?

Read: Galatians 4:4 and Isaiah 9:6-7

7. The Magi made a "careful search" for the Child. Tell a bit about your journey to Jesus and how you finally came to faith in Him. What resistance, if any, did you encounter along the way as you moved toward faith in the Savior?
8. Scripture tells us we've received "full rights of sons" through the Son that God sent. What are some of the "rights" we receive as children of God? Tell about how you are experiencing these glorious "rights" at this time in your life.
9. Read the following descriptions of Jesus slowly and thoughtfully... *"Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace."* These are powerful and moving declarations of who Jesus is. Which one strikes you the most and how have you experienced the truth of this name in your life?
