Primary Description: The role of the Pastor of Community Life and Growth is to develop and maintain Spiritual pathways to help as many people as possible to become totally committed to Jesus Christ.

Ministry Responsibilities:

1. Work with teams to develop Spiritual Growth Opportunities

- Facilitating/promoting and implementing “Welcome Home” membership events, follow up and contact attendees. Keep accurate data on the progress of all congregants.
- Help get new members assimilated into the life of Shoreline.
- Develop, lead and maintain classes through partnerships with mature believers.
- Plan cycle of classes, including curriculum, leaders, dates, facility usage, ministry publicity, follow-up, and next steps upon completion.
- Put plans through the Ministry Launch team before starting new ministries or classes.
- Develop pathways for spiritual growth that will help people become totally committed to Jesus Christ.
- Support various classes and Bible studies: i.e. Precept upon Precept Studies, Men’s Bible studies, Women’s studies, Pastor’s studies, etc.

2. Growing Shoreline members and attenders in Small Groups

- Develop a small group team that will provide consistent and continuing support for current and future small group leader
 - This team will: systematically recruit, equip and train small group leaders.

- Encourage a growing group of small group and leaders.
- Keep accurate records of all existing and new small groups.
- Communicate with leaders and facilitators to keep clarity of calendaring and potential church-wide initiatives.
- Coordinate a system of consistent advertising and updating for available groups and classes.

3. Shepherd and mentor leaders and facilitators to monitor health of their groups and classes.

4. Grow post Young Adult and Singles Community.

- Recruit, equip, and train leadership team for adult singles ministry.
- In conjunction with leaders in singles ministries, over see related events.
- Communicate with leaders and facilitators to keep clarity of calendaring and potential church-wide initiatives.

5. Pastoral Duties

- Serve in rotation with Pastoral staff in conducting weddings, funerals, baptisms, hospital visitation and general support for the community of believers.

6. Over see staff/office time
