Primary Description:

The Musical Director works in conjunction with the worship leaders to bring glory to God through music throughout the church. Leads and develops people to higher levels of excellence on the Music Team for Sunday morning and midweek services with supportive leadership that honors God and fulfills the overall mission, vision and purpose statements of Shoreline Community Church.

Status: Part Time

Time requirements:

- 30 Sunday Services and their accompanied practices
- All of the charts and arrangements for Sunday service
- Practices/Charts multiple performances for Christmas programs
- Christmas Eve Programs
- 150 Hours of musical Instructional Time for worship leaders/Parts for instrumentation.
- Meetings as required
- Support the choir director through arrangements and selection of music
- Helps to audition and place musicians and vocalists

Lines of Accountability: Pastor of Ministry Development

Ministry Responsibilities:

1. The Sunday Service- Participate in the planning and execution of high-quality, high-tech, relevant, creative, thematic services. These services are to communicate God's truth so that the deepest part of people's hearts may be reached and produce life-change.

- Supports all main service worship bands.
- Plans for worship in conjunction with the pastor and worship leaders a minimum of 12 weeks in advance. This cooperative planning, led by the

pastor, will outline all worship services, including themes, music, and special services.

- Plays keyboards when appropriate
- Makes Charts
- Brings musical expertise to increase the quality of the music
- Auditions players and helps to determine their placement
- Meets with staff regularly, individually or in groups, to ensure consistency in musical expectations

2. General Music Ministry

- Creates occasional special musical events in the church.
- Collaborates with a committee of volunteers on organizing a special Christmas concert series with the goal of increasing attendance and community recognition.

3. Other

- Acts as a consultant to the congregation in matters of sound system and instrument maintenance needs.
- Attend and take an active role in staff meetings and committees as possible.
- Work with appropriate committees in programs goals and budget preparation.
- Gets Charts with 2 weeks of lead time and create to deadlines.
- Helps to create a Christmas musical program for the community.
