Primary Description:

The Outreach Pastor will serve Shoreline Church through helping develop the outreach vision on our campus by partnering with our key influencers and spreading the vision for organic outreach within our leadership culture, each ministry of the church, the whole church gathered, and our church members as they scatter all over our community and world.

Status: Part time (8-10 hours a week on average)

Lines of Accountability: Lead Pastor

Ministry Responsibilities:

1. Leadership of the Outreach Influence Team

- Lead a quarterly Full Team Meeting of the Outreach Influence Team in partnership with the Lead Pastor. This will be a time to keep leaders accountable for their personal and ministry outreach temperature, to teach new outreach concepts, to bring all ministries together around upcoming outreach events, and allow each individual ministry seek help and support in their outreach ministry.
- Lead quarterly Outreach Clusters of strategic groups of leaders who are part of the Outreach Influence Team. These times are designed to create a space for accountability for each person's personal and ministry outreach temperature, for learning, and for vision sharing around the topic of evangelism.
- Lead quarterly One-On-One Meetings with each member of the Outreach Influence Team. These meetings will be a time when the Outreach Pastor keeps team members accountable to be raising their outreach temperature both personally and in their ministry. Also, he will offer encouragement, training, and support in the outreach ministry of each person on the Outreach Influence Team.
- Regular communication with and encouragement of OIT members through personal contact, e-mail communication, and other forms of communication.

- Regular prayer for all members of the OIT and for the ministries of Shoreline Community Church.

2. Support of Shoreline Outreach Ministries

- Function in partnership with the Director of Community Outreach and the Director of World Outreach to give encouragement in these areas of Shoreline's ministry and make sure we have synergy between all three levels of our Church Outreach / Community Outreach / and World Outreach.
- Meet regularly with the Lead Pastor to make sure the direction of Shoreline's Church Outreach works in concert with the vision and direction set by the Lead Pastor, the Management Team, and the L-Team.
- Work as a partner, as needed and able, on church-wide outreach initiatives.
- Work as a partner in Community Outreach Events, as able.
- Work as a partner in Shoreline's World Outreach efforts, as able.

3. General Pastoral Duties

- Attend Staff meetings as able.
- Attend Pastoral meetings as able.
- Function as an active member of Shoreline and the church pastoral team, in some of the following ways as needed, requested, and able: assisting in Sunday services, praying for people after services, performing weddings and funerals, participating in baptisms...any other area he wants to engage.
