### Primary Description:

To oversee the operation, integration, and maintenance of technology in the worship services, and auxiliary rooms throughout Shoreline. To oversee the volunteers in the Sound, Video, and Lighting Teams by providing training, encouragement and guidance on a weekly basis. To oversee the planning of new projects and integration of technology in those projects. Our main goal is to provide an atmosphere for people to feel at home and comfortable to worship God in.

**Lines of Accountability:** Pastor of Ministry Development

### Ministry Responsibilities:

#### 1. Sound

- To Maintain all audio equipment, obtain RMA and repair gear as needed, to charge batteries, and keep an updated inventory of usable and non-usable equipment.
- To provide or train volunteers to provide; Main house mix on Sunday morning worship service, to plan and organize stage layout, and line sheets and track sheets for Sunday. To record and archive multi-track session, encode and upload sermons to [www.shorlinechurch.org](http://www.shorlinechurch.org) via word-press.
- To serve as house engineer for all in house recording projects.
- To serve as or supply in house FOH engineer for ministry events that draw more than 300 people.

#### 2. Video

- To maintain video booth and projection systems.
- To train volunteers in the use of Pro Presenter, and video switching system.
- To train volunteers in the entry of lyrics, sermon notes, and video service elements.

### **3. Lighting**

- To maintain all lighting and theatrical electrical systems for the Worship Center. Keep an inventory of unused fixtures, replacement bulbs, safety cables, and C-Clamps.
- To train volunteers the basics of theatrical lighting concepts; aiming styles, DMX protocol, terminology. To train volunteers in the programming and operation of the lighting console, to program cue's, shows, and file management.
