Primary Description:

Every member of the band and singers are all leading our congregation in worship. This position exists to help lead our congregation in worship, to model a lifestyle of worship to our entire church, and to mentor/train others in their relationship with God and develop their holistic ability to lead others in worship.

Status: Full Time

Lines of Accountability: Pastor of Ministry Development

Ministry Responsibilities:

1. Worship Leading:

- Lead worship at the weekend services scheduled in advance on a yearly basis
- Leading worship directly for 36 Sundays a year and supporting directly on the platform for at least another 8 Sundays.
- Lead worship when called upon at retreats, conferences, staff meetings, men's gatherings, community outreach events, or at other times that may come up.
- Schedule Worship leaders for Staff meetings
- Work with "in-house" volunteer worship leaders
- Schedule rehearsals for singers and players when required
- Maintain clear lines of communication in a timely manner between all personnel involved in services and events

2. Programming and Leadership:

- Create and provide leadership for two congregational events per year
 - Example: a concert, with outside artists or the choir
- Attend planning meetings and contribute to the programming of services and special all church events

- Interview and audition singers and players
- Share in programming of special events and conferences
- Share in the responsibility of shepherding and disciplining Worship Team
- Teaching and training the Worship team and Choir
- Work with the Music Director to create a quarterly schedule of worship musicians, publicizing this list at least a month in advance of the coming quarter.
- Create set lists that connect with the sermon and service theme for worship
- Scout out new musicians and singers, incorporating them into the department as we seek to be volunteer led.
- Help maintain quality music in all areas of the church.
 - Meet with musicians and worship leaders from all other ministries
- Lead and oversee the Worship Admin, Partner with Music Director

3. Development:

- Develop volunteer bands along with part-time Music Director
- Work along side of the Pastor of Ministry Development to develop annual Ministry Plan and budget
- Develop Music School
 - Provide Driving leadership for the school
 - Teach students directly at least 6 hours a week
 - Monthly report of training and people involved

4. Other:

- Attend all staff meetings
- Adhere to the guidelines of SCC Employee Handbook
- Maintain positive relationships with staff
- Other duties as assigned.
